The Griffin RESA Dyslexia Endorsement will explore the critical components of language, literacy development, and neurobiological origins that assist in defining the needs of students with dyslexia. This three-course series will prepare participants to understand the five (5) language processing requirements, recognize the tenets of dyslexia, understand and apply progress monitoring and reporting with Curriculum Based Measures (CBMs) including graphing. Participants will also develop the skills to identify struggling readers and plan and implement interventions over time then reflect on their effectiveness. The instructional format will be completely virtual, offering both quality and convenience to busy educators seeking to develop a deeper understanding of language development and evidence-based reading instruction with dyslexia.
