## CLASS DESCRIPTION

The Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) requires school districts to monitor progress on the goals in the Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) for students with special needs. Progress monitoring is a scientifically based practice of specifically measuring progress regarding a specific area of need. Without appropriate progress monitoring, there is no way of knowing whether a student is making progress and whether revisions to the student's special education programming are necessary. In this class, participants will learn about writing measurable goals, selecting appropriate progress monitoring tools, and how to organize the materials in a readily accessible way.
