In this class, participants will explore the second half of the five pillars of reading and align the pillars to specially designed instructional strategies. Through evidence from the science of reading, participants will learn how to assess the language comprehension portion of Scarborough's Reading Rope for students with disabilities. The class will begin with fluency as the bridge from decoding to vocabulary and comprehension. Once the student's specific deficit skill is identified, the alignment of interventions will target student-specific concerns. The class will provide specific strategies to address the student's concerns. Please note that this class does not teach a particular program; it teaches strategies you can use the next day.
