CLASS DESCRIPTION

This 6-hour training provides participants with an understanding of how teachers may understand and treat problem behaviors in their classroom using an applied behavior analysis approach. Participants will learn the basic principles of applied behavior analysis and how they may be applied to understand and change problem behavior. A particular emphasis will be placed upon the importance of determining the function of problem behaviors prior to utilizing behavioral interventions to treat them. Participants will then learn the most effective and commonly used interventions for treating problem behaviors based on their respective behavioral function. Finally, participants will learn how to create solid behavior intervention plans.
